Talk on Quality Education

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell organised a talk on *Quality Education: An Analysis from an Economic Perspective* presented by Professor Saumen Chattopadhyay of Jawaharlal Nehru University on February 23, 2023. The talk was attended by third year students. Prof. Chattopadhyay focussed on the role of quality education delivered by both public and private sectors. He remarked that if economics is implemented into education then the institution would experience issues related to marketisation. Additionally, he analysed Adam Smith's view on improving the quality of education as well as Joseph Stiglitz's perception of what educational institutions should offer in order to improve quality education. Prof. Chattopadhyay drew a contrast between education production function and production function in Economics while providing examples to show why there are disparities in the quality of education. Finally, he touched upon the issue of public-private divide when delivering educational services, making it a highly rewarding, immersive and stimulating session.
