### **Objective of the Programme**

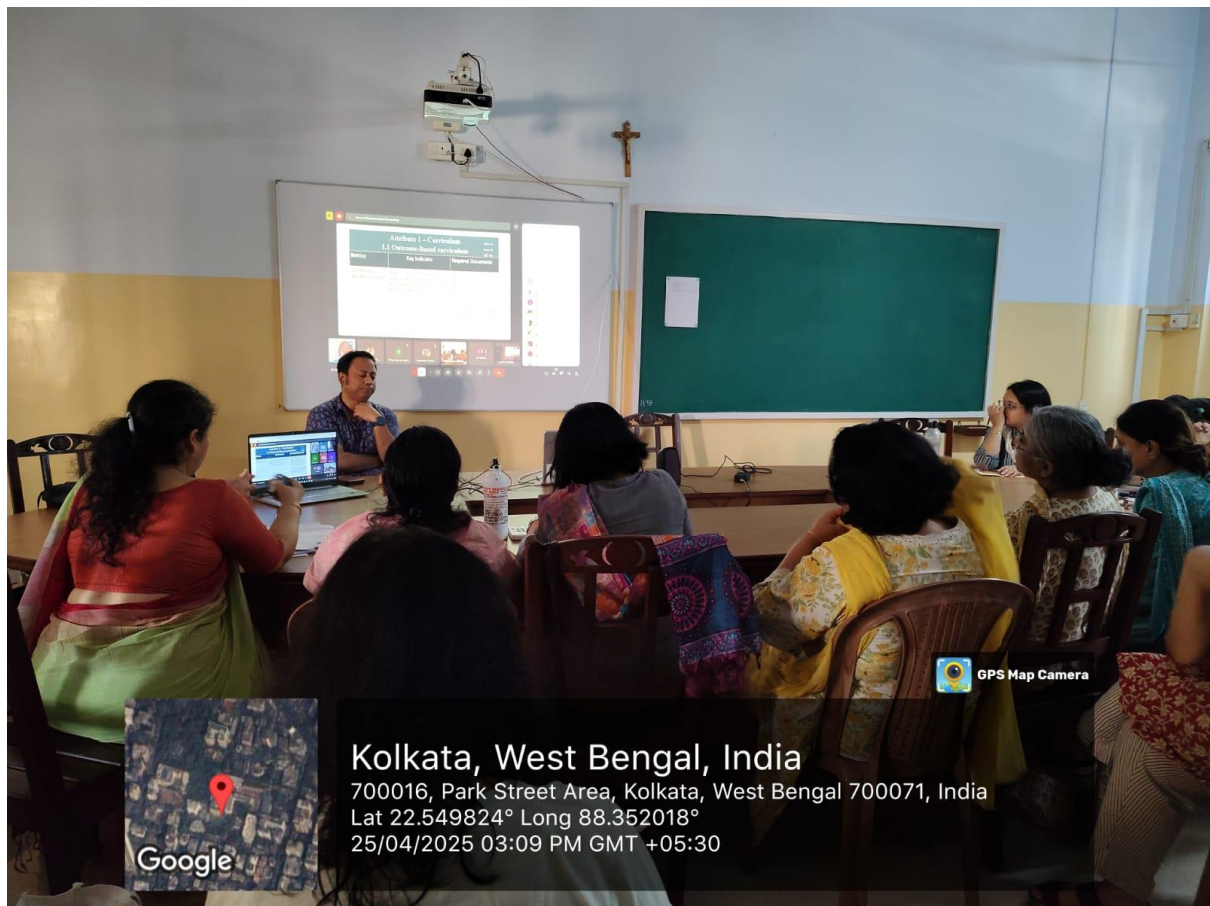
- Provide a comprehensive understanding of the new Binary Accreditation Framework introduced by NAAC.

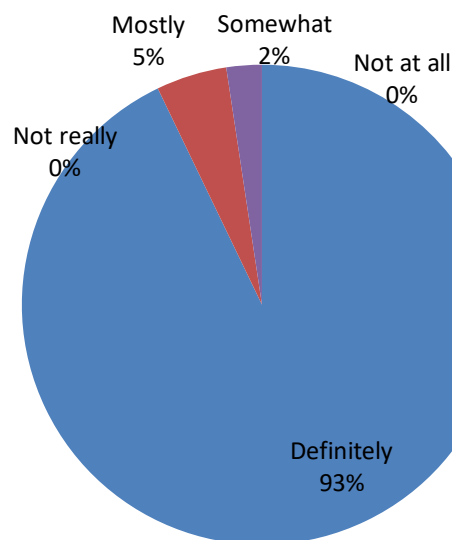

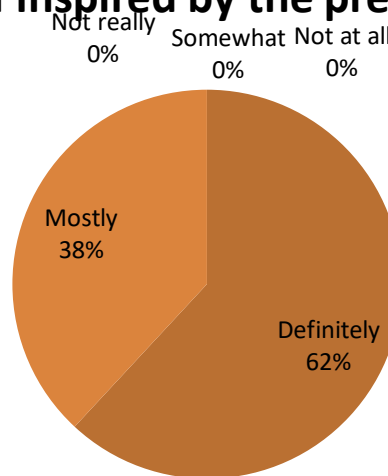

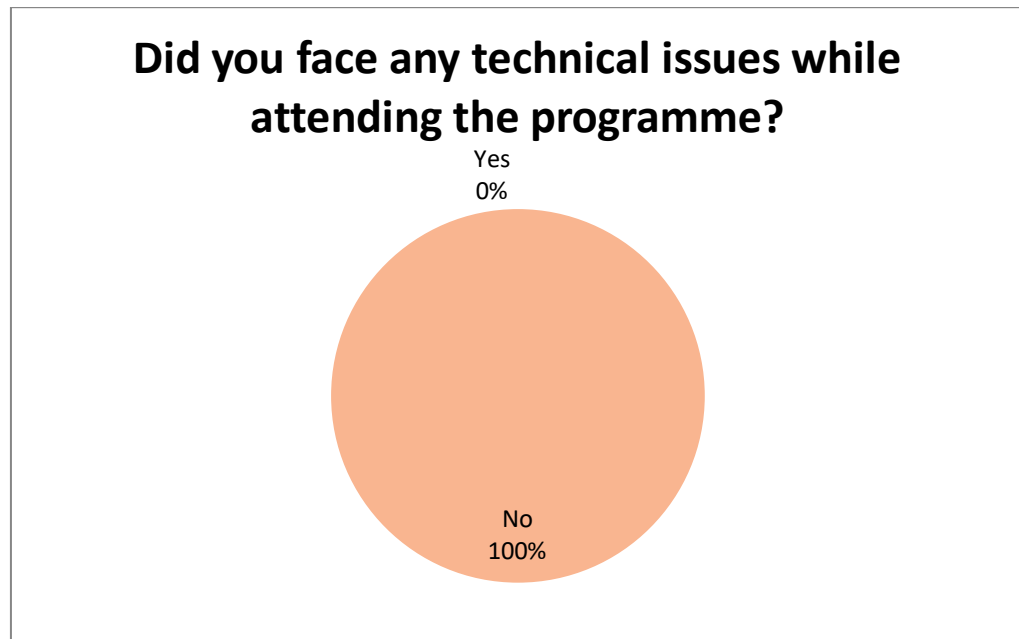
