
BRIEF REPORT ON NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME SOCIETY ACTIVITIES FOR 2021-2022

For the year 2021-22, the National Service Scheme Society has successfully organized both online and offline events and activities. The volunteers of the society have enthusiastically participated in at-home events, webinars, outreach programme as well as offline events, as and when necessary. The year was kick-started with the celebration of Vriksha Raksha Bandhan in the month of August, 2021. Thereafter, several events followed such as National Service Scheme Day celebration, a poster-making competition on the theme of dengue/malaria. National Service Scheme Society organized enriching webtalks with eminent resource persons such as a webtalk on Covid protocols in educational institutions with Dr. Kunal Sarkar, a webtalk on natural ways to promote immunity with Dr. N. Abdul Azeez and a webinar on rural entrepreneurship with Mrs. Tuti Sandhya. Further, the volunteers showed great enthusiasm in celebrating National Productivity Week observing the theme of self-reliance, as well as National Cleanliness Day. On the occasion of Women's Day, the NSS Society was grateful to have Dr. Sankhabela Mukherjee take a workshop on self-defense within the campus of our college. Finally, the introductory visit to the village of Harishpur in Naihati, adopted by Loreto College was also organized by the NSS Society. Overall, the National Service Scheme Society was able to engage its volunteers in meaningful service throughout the year.

WEBINAR ON RURAL ENTREPRENEURSHIP

A webinar on 'Rural Entrepreneurship' was organized by the Mahatma Gandhi National Council of Rural Entrepreneurship (MGNCRE) Cell in collaboration with the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), Loreto College, Kolkata, on the February 24, 2022. The resource person for the webinar was Mrs Tuti Sandhya, senior faculty MGNCRE, Ministry of Education, Government of India. A total of 66 students of the College participated in this webinar.

In the webinar, the students were familiarized with the concept of rural entrepreneurship and various economic hardships that the rural entrepreneurs face while indicating their probable solutions. The students were introduced to MGNCRE sponsored organizations like Rural Employment Development (RED) Cell and One District – One Product Scheme (ODOP), to encourage them to take up initiatives to choose entrepreneurship as a career and promote local products. Mrs Sandhya also explained how students with this knowledge can help to link the farming sector with the mainstream markets and promote the export of the products produced by the rural entrepreneurs throughout the country by way of pursuing social entrepreneurship. The webinar helped the students to realize the need for the upliftment of the rural poor for sustainable growth of the economy.

Vriksha Raksha Bandhan is an initiative taken by MGNCRE (Mahatma Gandhi National Council of Rural Education) in collaboration with the NSS (National Service Scheme) of Loreto College. 
