1. **CLINICAL POSTINGS:** Each trainee gets different postings for two academic years. These postings are as listed below:

Note:

- During Adult Psychiatry posting, trainees also go for Community Mental Health work (e.g., School Mental Health, Awareness camps etc.) and attend out-reach clinics.
- During Adult Psychiatry posting, the trainees attend a weekly Epilepsy clinic for two months.
- Number of working days in a year is around 280 and the working hours are eight per day.
- Working hours include hours allotted for didactic lectures, case-conference, seminars etc.
- Training in In-patient Psychological Testing, In-patient Psychotherapy and Neuropsychology are part of Adult Psychiatry posting.

2. **DETAILS OF CLINICAL WORKS**

2.1. **CASE WORK-UP:** On completion of the 1st year of training, a trainee is expected to have competence in the following areas:

- 2.1.1. Taking a detailed case history.
- 2.1.2. Doing a Mental Status Examination.
- 2.1.3. Evolving the diagnostic formulation.
- 2.1.4. Classifying a case as per DSM/ ICD

2.2 **PSYCHODIAGNOSTICS:** On completion of training, a trainee is expected to be able to administer, score, interpret and report psychological tests/scales in the following areas:

- 2.2.1 Objective Tests of Personality
- 2.2.2 Projective Tests of Personality
- 2.2.3 Intelligence tests
- 2.2.4 Neuropsychological Tests
- 2.2.5 Developmental Schedules
- 2.2.6 Adjustment Scales
- 2.2.7 Psychopathology Rating Scales

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3. **CLINICAL WORK:** The minimum prescribed clinical work, under supervision, for a trainee is listed below:

*Management includes psycho-education, counselling and various types of psychotherapies.

4. **SUBMISSIONS:** Prior to appearing for the Part I examination, each trainee should submit, for evaluation, 10 *Psychological Assessment* case reports. Similarly, prior to appearing for the final Part II examination each trainee has to submit 10 *Psychological Management* case reports.
5. **ACADEMIC PROGRAMS:** Each trainee has to participate for a total of six hours per week in *Seminars, Journal Clubs, and Case Conferences*. Total number of hours of participation in these activities is 240 per year. In addition to attending all academic programs, each trainee has to present a few seminars on allotted topics, do journal clubs and present psychological (assessment and therapy) case reports in case conferences.
6. **RESEARCH:** Before the completion of the training, each trainee has to submit a dissertation on the clinical research work carried out by him/her under supervision.
7. **DIDACTIC LECTURES IN THEORY PAPERS:** The specialists in specific areas, as listed below, expose the trainees to didactic lectures:
