




Foster Entrepreneurial Skills through Collaborations


- The Loreto College Incubation Centre celebrated young entrepreneurs by organizing a **sale and exhibition of unique business ideas** on September 23, 2022.




Community Engagement through Outreach Programmes


GREEN CAMPUS


GREEN CAMPUS



GREEN CAMPUS
