Action Taken Report

2022-2023

In order to promote institutional quality enhancement and sustenance, the Internal Quality Assurance Cell of Loreto College has adopted relevant quality academic programmes. Keeping the objective of academic excellence with all-round development, the recommendations of the various stakeholders have been incorporated. The various initiatives adopted to empower young women are in tandem with the Vision and Mission of the institution.

IQAC Initiatives

In order to facilitate creation of a student-centred educational setting for quality education, Internal Quality Assurance Cell acts as a nodal agency of the institution for coordinating quality related programmes.

- A 30-hour course on Logical Reasoning and Data Interpretation was introduced to help the students build confidence and thinking skills, help stay focused and save time. The 30-hour course on Basic Mathematics for Competitive examinations was conducted and successfully completed.
- A Talk on **Richness of College life** by an alumnus Ms. Chirimar was organised to help the students realise the need to develop values of humility, discipline, modesty and time management while balancing academics and other passions.
- A Talk by Willis Towers Watson, a multinational insurance advisor company, was organised to brief the students of the Department of Economics and students opting for Elective Economics about the opening in the field of Actuarial Science and provide information about their recruitment process. It helped the students gain information about alternative career opportunities.
- A Talk on Energy Conservation and Energy Efficiency by Petroleum Conservation Research Association, a Government of India enterprise under Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas was organised as an awareness programme helping the students realise the importance of prudent use of fossil fuels.
- An International Symposium on Environmental Sustainability was organised in collaboration with Lions Club International District 322 B1 and Coordinating Club, Lions Club of Calcutta Mahanagar to help the students realise the need to unleash the knowledge and capability of women for effective climate change mitigation. Dr. Rajesh Kumar, IPS DGP Kolkata and Member Secretary of West Bengal Pollution Control Board was the resource person followed by Ms. Kehkashan Basu, President of Green Hope Foundation who spoke from Canada
- Under LEADS (Loreto Empowerment and Development Series), a talk on Quality Education, one of the SDGs was organised to develop ideas about public- private divide in the delivery of education and figure out alternative ways to improve quality of education. Prof. Saumen Chattopadhyay of Jawaharlal Nehru University was the resource person.
- A National Seminar was organised on **Gender Mainstreaming: The Road Ahead** for the faculty and students to analyse the ways in which societal institutions and power structures impact

gender mainstreaming. Justice Indira Banerjee, Former Judge of Supreme Court delivered the keynote address which preceded a special lecture by Prof. Rumki Basu, Head, Centre for Public Policy and Governance. A panel discussion was held comprising Dr. Maria Fernandes, member of West Bengal Commission for Women, Mrs. Ananya Chakraborty, Advisor to the West Bengal Commission for the Protection of Child Rights, Dr. Rosalin Mishra, President of Parichay Foundation and chaired by Prof. Arijita Dutta, University of Calcutta. In the last segment, presentations were made by different scholars from different colleges and universities across the country.

Facilitating Use of Hybrid Mode:

In order to motivate students, strive for excellence and have exposure and access to better human resources, IQAC has organised events where hybrid mode was used. On several occasions the national and international speakers delivered lectures using the online mode and the students attended them physically.

The Departments have also organised events using hybrid mode to accommodate speakers of repute both nationally and internationally for enhancement of quality.

Online feedback forms are circulated to students and/ or teachers to understand the impact of the programme, relevance and outcome of the event.

Celebrating Days of National and International Importance

75th **year of Independence Day** was celebrated on August 15, 2022 based on the theme Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav.

On **September 16, 2022, International Day for Preservation of Ozone layer** was commemorated through an online poster competition.

On **November 23, 2022, National Education Day** was celebrated with an invigorating lecture and the release of a college publication, **Education....Gleanings**.

On December2, 2022, National Pollution Prevention Day was kept up. Dr. Kalyan Rudra, Chairman of West Bengal Pollution Control Board addressed the students; this was followed by a poster presentation by the students.

On **December 9, 2022,** students recalled **International Human Rights Day.**

On April 29, 2023, World Book Day and Copyright Day was celebrated to ensure literacy, promote cultural diversity and understanding, and preserve the creative economy.

World Environment Day was celebrated through a series of activities during May-June 2023. On **June 5, 2023**, 10 students accompanied by two faculty members attended a programme organised by West Bengal Pollution Control Board at Biswa Bangla Convention Centre.

Academic Quality Enhancement

The different departments have organised various lectures and events to provide a better exposure to students to have a comprehensive idea beyond classroom teaching.

Research Promotion

In order to develop the analytical skills and logical reasoning among the students and have a better orientation towards research, the Research Cell of the college organised events throughout the year.

The various departments in collaboration with IQAC have also organised events to promote the culture of research among the students.

- A Special Lecture, Unravelling Man's Life and Society: A Qualitative Discourse was organised by the Department of Human Rights in collaboration with IQAC and delivered by Suvendu Maji, Assistant Professor, Department of Anthropology, University of Calcutta on November 25, 2022.
- A special lecture on **Interrogating Qualitative Research: Differences, Challenges and Possibilities** was organised by Department of Sociology in collaboration with the IQAC and delivered by Dr. Abhijit Dasgupta, Assistant Professor of Sociology at GITAM University, Visakhapatnam on December 8, 2022.
- A talk, **Research Methods in Social Sciences: Anomaly or Necessity** was organised by Department of History in collaboration with IQAC on January 7, 2023. Ms. Mallika Roy Choudhury covered various concepts and issues with research methods. Through the course of the talk the need for rigour in the design, method and methodology of research was emphasized upon with various examples from history.
