Activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the institution:

The institution has attempted to upgrade itself with new technological infrastructure to enhance the teaching-learning process. It has also tried to adopt an interdisciplinary approach to academics. The institution strives to maintain its reputation for academic excellence while encouraging its students to do community work and social service.

- The Geography Department held a Bridge Course for the 1st Year students (Honours and General) to enable the students to academically adjust to the subject at college. Here Mathematics, Trigonometry, Chemistry, Geology, introduction to various types of maps, and census and administrative data was taught.
- Educational excursions: In February 2008, the out-going Third Year History students were taken on a tour of historical sites on the Hooghly river, viz. Hanseswari temple in Bansberia, the Imambara & Bandel Church as well as the French Institute in Chandernagore. The Geography Department also organized field trips for students to create ecological and environmental awareness.

Improvements in library services:

To ensure full and effective use of the Library, the following measures have been taken:

- Total collection made up of 46351 books of which 758 was added in 2007-2008
- 69 Journals and magazines, both Indian and foreign, of which 6 were added and 5 renewed.
- 201 CDs and DVDs
- 1240 Text Books in the Book Bank
- Computerization of the central library is in progress with standard digital software, LIBSYS with 5-user license. 5 computers are dedicated to this purpose. Data entry is being done by the Librarian and Library support staff. Computerized Circulation has been started through Bar Coded Library Tickets. 19951 books have been bar-coded so far.

Technology upgradation:

Computer and internet access and training to teachers and students:

Through the various compulsory and special courses, the students were trained for employment in the future. Training on MS PowerPoint was given to the teachers to enhance the teaching – learning process.

Financial aid to students:

Financial aid and scholarships are provided to needy students. Partial scholarships are provided. 4 members of staff helped students financially for their educational costs.

Activities and support from the Alumnae Association:

- The Alumnae Association assisted economically challenged students by contributing from an Endowment Fund.
- The Association awards a cash prize and a plaque for the best General Course student.
- The Association actively supports the college in all its activities and organizes a Reunion each year for its ex-pupils. The Association also helps organize the College Open Day every year.

Although there is no formal Parent-Teacher Association, the Principal and teachers often interact with the parents of students regarding their academic progress. Parents are also invited to attend the Awards Ceremony each year when their wards receive prizes and this provides an apt occasion for parents and teachers to meet. A parent of a current student is also asked to be on the Governing Body of the college each year.

Health Services:

A sick room and the services of a nurse are available on the college premises. First aid material and relief rendering common drugs are available in the main office for emergencies.

Performance in sports activities:

Students participated in the 8th Inter Non-Govt colleges District Athletic Meet and Football Championship.

Incentives to outstanding sportspersons:

A special medal for Achievement in Sport was awarded to a student.

Student achievements and awards:

- Students presented papers at conferences within the college as well as outside, for instance in St. Xavier's College, Kolkata.
- Outstanding students were awarded prizes on the day of the Awards Ceremony.
- Students of Economics participated in an Inter College Debate cum Group Discussion on the topic "Land for Industrialization: Economic Challenges and Benefits" organized by Muralidhar Girl's College, Kolkata on 15th February 2008. Atrayee Biswas of Loreto College won the "Best Speaker" award.
