### ***Activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the institution:***

The college has made an effort to attain the goals of pursuing academic excellence, enhancement of knowledge and all-round development. It encourages critical thinking, develops problem-solving abilities and initiates research. It has undertaken the following measures:

- Self-financing certificate GIS course for MAP INFO 8.5 Version for the 3<sup>rd</sup> year Geography General course students.

### ***Innovations in curricular design and transaction:***

The college has to follow the curriculum designed by the University of Calcutta but encourages students to think beyond the syllabus and make them interested in their respective subjects through diverse means

- Regular educational excursions to places of historical, cultural and geographical importance. For example, Geography students were taken to Andhra Pradesh to study the symbiotic relationship between Horsley Hills and Angallu settlement. History students visited the French Institute in Chandernagore which was earlier a French settlement.

- Creative writing courses and competitions to encourage literary creativity
- Publishing and editing workshops
- Street plays on relevant social issues
- Students seminars and paper presentations
- Group discussions by students
- A selection of the work of students of the Creative Writing course was published in a book entitled *Twisted Forever: Old Tales Made New*.

Training on Photoshop was given to the teachers and students. All students and teachers have free access to the internet and the facility of taking printouts at a subsidized rate.

Financial aid and scholarships are provided to needy students. Partial scholarships are provided.

***Activities and support from the Alumnae Association:***

The Alumnae Association provides financial aid to needy students through endowments and awards a prize each year to the best General Course student. The Association also organizes a Reunion each year so that its ex-pupils can stay in touch with their college. The Association helps organize the College Open Day every year by encouraging women entrepreneurs and NGOs to participate in the Open Day.

There is no formal Parent-Teacher Association but parents interact informally with teachers and the Principal regarding the progress of their wards. This interaction often takes place on the day of the Awards Ceremony.

A sick room and the services of a nurse are available on the college premises. First aid kit and relief rendering common drugs are available in the main office for emergencies.

### ***Performance in sports activities:***

In 2009, one of our students Madhurima Das participated in the All India Inter Varsity Meet held at Pong Dam in Himachal Pradesh. In the women's fours category she received a gold medal in Rowing for 500m, bronze for 1000m and in the women's pair she was awarded bronze for the 1000m and silver for 500m.

- The college held an Annual Sports Day on 2 February, 2009 to encourage the students to take an interest in sports.
